Major Renovation/Addition to Lodge in Boyle



We recently began a new seniors' lodge addition/renovation project for the Wildrose Villa Lodge in Boyle, Alberta. The project entails:

A two-storey addition

- with 11 enlarged lodge units on the first floor and;
- 22 supportive living units on the second floor.

Renovation

- Retrofit of the 39 existing single lodge units into 22 spacious units
- enlarging the dining room and kitchen.

The lodge's safety will also be improved with the addition of a sprinkler system to the entire facility. The addition and reno will improve comfort, safety, and quality of life for Wildrose Villa's residents.
