Staff News – Lunchtime Foosball Tournament



Project Update: Saddle Lake Health Centre

The Saddle Lake Health Centre project is a major expansion and renovation of the existing health centre. It is a multi-phase project with a total of six zones: multi-purpose wing, coordinated home care wing, public health wing, medical wing, administration wing, and a pharmacy. There were three additions to the facility, as well as reconfiguration of the existing program spaces and complete upgrades to the mechanical and electrical systems, data/telecom systems, interior architectural finishes, and exterior improvements. Currently, the multi-purpose wing is 100% completed, medical wing is at 90%, and coordinated home care wing is at 80%. The project was carefully phased to allow the facility to remain fully functional throughout construction. Construction is expected to be finished in May of 2019.
