New Projects at Red Deer Polytechnic

Berry Architecture has two new projects on the go with Red Deer Polytechnic. The first is a conversion of an existing lecture lab into a Biology Lab at Bio Safety Level 2. The space will have specialized electrical and ventilation requirements, must meet Canadian Biosafety standards, have cleanable surfaces, and be barrier free. The project includes a new air handling unit for this room, as well as provisions for a possible future lab in the same area.

The second project is the addition of a structure above the existing roof of the 800 Wing that is currently overloaded due to the weight of existing glycol heating lines and snow loads. The new structure will carry the snow loads and assist with carrying the glycol lines. The new roof structure will be fully sealed with an SBS roof.
