Project Update: Invermere Seniors' Housing

Berry Architecture is working with Generation Homes to provide design concepts for a prospective seniors' living apartment in Invermere, BC. Lakeview Manor is designed to house 62 suites, comprised of one or two bedroom units, some with wheelchair accessibility. The many amenities will include generous balconies, accessible hallways and elevators, common outdoor spaces, and rental suites for guests. The project includes commercial retail units (CRUs) on the main floor with direct access from 7th Avenue. This proposed concept takes advantage of the different levels of the site and the mountain views, while considering the adjacent site context. Project is currently in the initial schematic design phase.
