BAA's Airport Projects

A new project type at Berry Architecture is our recent foray into airport architecture! We have two projects currently on the go. The first is a new aircraft hangar in Fairmont, BC and the second is the Yellowstone Airport in Yellowstone National Park, in collaboration with Montana-based architecture firm, A&E Design. For the Fairmont Hangar project, we are providing full architectural consultant services, and for the Yellowstone Airport, we are assisting the A&E team with the Construction Documents phase. The Fairmont hangar is a Design-Build project that includes hangar space for planes and helicopters, as well as pilots' offices, workshop, and ancillary rooms. The Yellowstone Airport project is a new terminal—the design concept responds to the

values, culture, and unique environment of Yellowstone Park. It is a two-gate terminal with all required airport services: ticketing, security screening, baggage handling, administration, and building services. Amenities include passenger lounges, outdoor patio with runway views, concessions, and car rental services.
